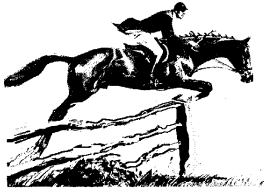

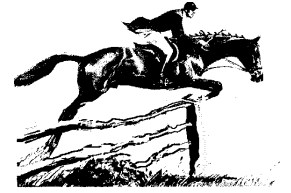

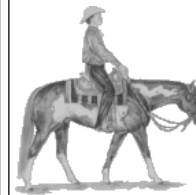

- ❖ Show does not plan to, but does reserve the right to alter required classes. Changes will be posted at entry stand.
- ❖ Any classes listed that are not held on a particular show, obviously don't count! In classes where it says "or", you can show in each class if eligible, but we will only count the class where you place higher. Champion & Reserve Championships are for each show weekend (be it one show or more).
- ❖ Exhibitors must show in a minimum of 4 classes in division (3 for pony div.) to qualify for championship in that division.
- ❖ We appreciate it if you can pick up your award on show day. We will hold it only until the next show. If it is not picked up by then the award is forfeited. Awards at the last show will not be held after the conclusion of the show. Please have a friend pick up your award if you have to leave before it is tabulated. Awards will not be mailed.
- ❖ Points are awarded on the same point value as charted in the VHSA rule book. Ties will be broken by a flip of a coin.
