All floats recognized as such by the judges will receive \$5 unless they win a prize. Decisions of the judges are final. In case of a class of less than three (3) entries, prizes will be awarded according to merit at the discretion of the judges. All entries, except Class 9, are judged on a point system: appearance - 50 points, originality - 50 points, and effort - 50 points. Four (4) judges are involved on an individual basis. A maximum of 450 points is possible. Single entry with the highest point total will win GRAND PRIZE. In case of a tie, first and second prizes will be combined and divided equally between the two tied entries. Second and third prizes will be combined in case of a tie at second place. Third prize will be eliminated. Announcement of prizes will be announced after the parade.

Parade entries will assemble at Fairgrounds. Floats are to assemble at 11:00 am; horses, and horse-drawn wagons at 11:30 am; and walking entries at 12:30 pm. **THE PARADE WILL START AT 1:00 pm.** All floats recognized as such by the judges will be judged at 11:30 am prior to the start of the parade. This gives judges more time and better opportunity to see and judge all floats.
