Rules

ENTRY FEES: 4-H Classes, Owner to Ride and Carl Dellinger Memorial Class - Free; Regular Classes - \$5.00; Championship Classes - \$6.00. Entries received after July 20, 2012, will be charged a one time only post entry fee of \$5.00 per horse or pony. Entry Fee or signed blank check must accompany entry form. No telephone or e-mail entries will be accepted. There will be an additional charge of \$28.00 for any check returned by the bank.

PASSES: There will be two (2) FREE PASSES PER HORSE OR PONY mailed if entries are received on or before July 14, 2012. All exhibitors without passes must pay regular gate admission - no exceptions and no refunds for those that have to pay.

Only tow vehicles allowed on the grounds.

COGGINS; New Hampshire Horses: A negative USDA-approved Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) test (i.e. Coggins or Elisa) within the previous twelve (12) months is recommended. **Out-of-State Animals:** All equines entering the State of New Hampshire must be accompanied by a current negative A.G.I.D. or ELISA (Coggins) test for Equine Infectious Anemia conducted within six (6) months prior to entry.

RABIES: Must present proof of Rabies Shots at horse show office.

RIBBONS: Ribbons will be awarded through six (6) places in all classes.

AGE as of January 1, 2012: Adults - 19 and over; Youth - 18 years of age and under; Walk-Trot - 12 years and under. Leadline - 8 years and under; 4-H - Juniors 11 -13 & Seniors 14 - 18: or unless otherwise noted in the program.

All exhibitors age 18 and under must wear headgear approved by and conform to the ASTM standards. Harness must be secured and properly fitted.

Exhibitors in all classes shall be neatly and cleanly attired appropriately for the class in which they are exhibiting. Chaps, derbies and coats are optional.

No training equipment will be allowed in the ring.

The Management reserved the right to combine or cancel classes that have fewer than four (4) entries.

Any exhibitor in a walk, trot/jog class cannot enter a class requiring a canter/lope.

Also, any exhibitor in a class requiring a canter/lope will not be eligible for a walk, trot/jog only class.

4-H DIVISION

Open only to members enrolled in a 4-H club (New Hampshire or Vermont) fulfilling the requirements as stated in the Member's Project Guide. Exhibitor must provide a copy of their current **4-H Animal Approval Form**. Classes to be judged according to 4-H rules.

Class # 1- 4-H Fitting and Showmanship. A) Junior or B) Senior - Ribbons & Trophy

Class # 9 - 4-H Equitation - Open. A) Junior or B) Senior - Ribbons and Trophy

Class # 24 - 4-H Pleasure Horse Class - A) Junior or B) Senior - Ribbons & Trophy

EQUITATION DIVISION

Horses to enter the ring at a walk. Riders to be judged at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope both ways of the ring and must be on the correct lead. Martingales prohibited. Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider suitability of horse to rider. All horses are required to back. Judge may ask for additional individual performance.

Class # 10 - Adult Western/Reining Seat Equitation. Ribbons and Trophy

Class # 11 - Adult Saddle Seat Equitation. Ribbons and Trophy

Class #12 - Adult Hunt Seat Equitation. Ribbons and Trophy

Class # 25 - Adult Equitation Championship - Open. To be eligible, riders must have been entered, shown and judged in Class # 10, 11, or 12. Ribbons and Trophy

Class #19 - Youth Western/Reining Seat Equitation. Ribbons and Trophy

Class #20 - Youth Saddle Seat Equitation. Ribbons and Trophy

Class #21 - Youth Hunt Seat Equitation. Ribbons and Trophy

Class #35 - Youth Equitation Championship - Open. To be eligible, riders must have been entered, shown and judged in Class #19, 20 or 21. Ribbons and Trophy

EQUITATION - WALK-TROT/JOG

Any riders in walk-trot/jog are not eligible to show in a canter/lope class at this show. Martingales prohibited. Riders to be judged at a walk, trot/jog both ways of the ring. Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse to rider. Horses are required to back.

Class # 13 - Adult Walk-Trot/Jog Equitation - Open. Ribbons and Trophy.

Class # 14 - Youth Walk-Trot/Jog Equitation - Open. Ribbons and Trophy

LEADLINE DIVISION

Open to riders 8 and under. Riders cannot compete in any other classes except leadline at this show. An adult shall be required to lead entry. Handlers and riders shall be properly attired. To be shown at a walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. Rider must be able to ride unassisted. Classes will be judged on elementary fundamentals of horsemanship. Suitability of mount to rider to count.

Class # 23 - Leadline Equitation - Open - Trophy and Ribbons

Class # 33 - Leadline Pleasure - Open - Trophy and Ribbons

MINI HORSE DIVISION

Mini Horses are not eligible to compete in any pony and/or horse classes at this show. This Division is open to Section "A" and "B" Division Horses

Class #8 - Mini Horse in Hand. To be shown in hand at a walk and trot both ways of the ring, halter or bridle permitted. Whips prohibited. Horses must not be stretched. To be judged on conformation, type, soundness, quality, presence and manners. Ribbons and Trophy

Class #17 - Mini Horse Driving.. Horses to be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, collected trot and working trot. Horses will enter the ring counterclockwise at a collected trot. Horses will be required to stand quietly and rein back. Driving is to be judged on 60% on performance, manners and way of going; 30% on condition, fit and appropriateness of harness and vehicle and 10% on neatness and appropriateness of attire and overall impression. Trophy and Ribbons.

OPEN SHOWMANSHIP

To be judged on showmanship with equine shown in hand, standing and at a walk and trot on the line. To be judged 40% on condition, grooming, tack, 10% on exhibitor appearance and 50% on leading, showing to best advantage and poise.

Class #2 - Adult Showmanship - Trophy and Ribbons

Class #3 - Youth Showmanship - Trophy and Ribbons

HORSE IN HAND DIVISION

Horses can only show in one class (no cross entering) in this Division.

Class #4 - Western Horse in Hand. Entries shall be judged at a walk and jog on the line and then standing individually. Emphasis shall be placed on type, conformation, substance, quality and manners as a Western mount. Trophy and Ribbons

Class #5 - English Horse in Hand (Saddle Seat). To be shown in hand and judged standing for type, quality, conformation, finish and suitability as a Saddle Seat mount. Trophy and Ribbons

Class #6 - Hunter Horse in Hand. To be shown in hand and judged standing for type, quality, conformation, finish and suitability as at Hunter mount. Trophy and Ribbons.

PONY DIVISION

Class #7 - Pony in Hand. Open to all ponies 14.2 hands and under. To be judged individually, standing, and then at a walk and trot on the line. To be judged on breed type, conformation, quality, substance, way of going, disposition and manners. Trophy and Ribbons.

Class # 18 - Pony Pleasure Under Saddle - Open. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope with extreme speed to be penalize. To be judged on manners, performance and quality. Trophy and Ribbons.

Class #37 - Pony Pleasure under Saddle Championship - Open. Specifications same as qualifying class. Open to ponies that have been entered, shown and judged in Class #18. Trophy and Ribbons.

JUNIOR EXHIBITOR'S HACK

Class #16 - Junior Exhibitor's Hack. Open to Saddle Seat or Hunt Seat horses. To be ridden by children under 18 years of age. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter on a reasonably loose rein but without loss of contact. Shall be judged on manners, performance, suitability and quality. May be divided "under 14" or "14 - 18" years of age. Trophy and Ribbons.

Class #32 - Junior Exhibitor's Hack Championship. Specifications same as qualifying class. Open to horses or ponies that have been entered, shown and judged in Class #16. Trophy and Ribbons.

ROAD HACK DIVISION

Class #22 - Road Hack. Open to Saddle Seat and Hunt Seat horses. Shall be shown on a reasonably loose rein without loss of contact at a flat-footed walk, trot, extended trot, canter and hand gallop. Shall stand quietly and back readily. Shall be judged on performance, substance and manners. Trophy and Ribbons.

Class #41 - Road Hack Championship. Specifications same as qualifying class. To be eligible, horses must have been entered, shown and judged in Class # 22. Trophy and Ribbons.

WALK-TROT/JOG PLEASURE

Any rider in walk-trot/jog class are not eligible to show in any canter/lope class at this show. To be shown at a walk and trot/jog only. Reverse at the walk only. To be judged on manners, suitability or a horse/pony to rider and performance.

Class #29 - Adult Walk-Trot/Jog Pleasure - Open. Trophy and Ribbons

Class #30 - Youth Walk-Trot/Jog Pleasure - Open. Trophy and Ribbons

PLEASURE DIVISION

Class #15 - Ladies Pleasure Horse. Riders to be 19 years of age or over. May be shown Saddle Seat, Hunt Seat or Western. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog or canter/lope. May be asked to back. To be judged on manners, performance and suitability. Trophy and Ribbons.

Class #36 - Gentlemen's Pleasure Horse. Rides to be 19 years of age or over. May be shown Saddle Seat, Hunt Seat or Western. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope May be asked to back. To be judged on manners, performance and suitability. Trophy and Ribbons.

Class #26 - Hunter Pleasure Horse. Open to horses of a hunter type. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. To be judged on manners, performance, quality presence, substance and soundness. Trophy and Ribbons.

Class #38 - Hunter Pleasure Horse Championship. Specifications same as qualifying class. To be eligible, horses must have been entered, shown and judged in Class # 26. Trophy and Ribbons.

Class #27 - Western Pleasure Horse. Open to horses ordinarily used for pleasure purposes. To be shown at a walk, jog and lope. On a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. All horses are required to back. To be judged on manners, performance and quality. Trophy and Ribbons.

Class #39 - Western Pleasure Horse Championship. Specifications same as qualifying class. To be eligible, horses must have been entered, shown and judged in Class #27. Trophy and Ribbons.

Class #28 - Saddle Seat Pleasure Horse. Open to horses ordinarily used for pleasure purposes. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Reverse at the walk only. Loose rein on command of the judge only, but without loss of contact. All horses required to back. To be judged on manners, performance and quality. Trophy and Ribbons.

Class #40 - Saddle Seat Pleasure Horse Championship. Specifications same as qualifying class. To be eligible, horses must have been entered, shown and judged in Class #28. Trophy and Ribbons.

MEMORIAL TROPHY CLASSES

Class #31 - **Owner to Ride.** Open to horses and/or ponies. Rider must be owner on the entry form. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope both ways of the ring. To be judged on manners, performance and suitability to rider. Entries to be asked to back. In **Memory of Calvin Perkins.** Trophy and Ribbons. No Charge

Class #34 - **Carl Dellinger Memorial Pleasure Horse Class - Open.** All entries must have been entered and shown in at least one pleasure class at this show in a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint but without loss of contact. All horses required to back. To be judged on manners, performance and quality. All horses shall be judged on their respective merits regardless of type. Trophy and Ribbons. No Charge

GAMES

Class #42 - Sit-A-Buck (must provide your own dollar). Winner gets the buck. Ribbons

Class #43 - Egg and Spoon. Trophy and Ribbons. No Charge

TRAIL DIVISION

All trail classes will be held in the North Haverhill Fair Forest. To be judged between 9:30 a.m. and 12:00 noon. No horse may enter more than one class. Martingales not allowed. Judged for suitability for use on country trails. Must demonstrate free and quiet way of going with comfort to rider and to horse or pony. The gait between obstacles will be at the discretion of the judge. Time in excess of 30 seconds in approaching an obstacle will eliminate the score for that obstacle.

Class #44 - Trail Horse - Saddle Seat. Trophy and Ribbons

Class #45 - Trail Horse - Western. Trophy and Ribbons

Class #46 - Trail Horse - Hunter. Trophy and Ribbons

Class #47 - Trail Horse - Adult Walk-Trot/Jog. Trophy and Ribbons

Class #48 - Trail Horse - Youth Walk-Trot/Jog. Trophy and Ribbons

Class #49 - Pony Trail - Open. Trophy and Ribbons

Class #50 - Leadline Trail - Open. (An adult shall be required to lead entry) Trophy and Ribbons

Class #51 - Mini Horse Trail. Entrants to be judged on performance with emphasis on manners, response to the handler and attitude. Trophy and Ribbons.
